Jerzy Buzek was born in 1940 in Śmiłowice (Silesian Voivodeship). A politician, former Prime Minister of Poland and former President of the European Parliament. In 1999, he brought Poland into the NATO structures and in 1997 he initiated negotiations with the European Union. Since 2004 an MP to the European Parliament and currently the President of the Committee on Industry, Research and Energy (ITRE), as well as the Conference of Committee Chairmen at the European Parliament, and Initiator of the Energy Community, rapporteur of the 7th Framework Programme for research, energy technologies strategies and the internal energy market in the EU.

He graduated as an engineer from universities in Gliwice and Cambridge. He is the author of over 200 scientific publications. He is a scholar, community activist, and politician.

His restless energy found an outlet in the European Parliament, to which he was elected, obtaining the best result in Poland. He participated in numerous Parliamentary Committees: Industry, Research and Energy, Environment, Public Health and Food Safety, as well as Counteracting Climate Change. He was also a member in the following European Parliament Delegations to: the EU-Ukraine Parliamentary Cooperation Committee, Delegation for relations with the Southwest Asian countries and the ASEAN (Association of Southeast Asian Nations). On July 14, 2009, he was elected the President of the European Parliament obtaining 555 out of 644 valid votes - this was the biggest support that a President of the EP obtained since 1979, i.e. since the first direct election. He was the first President elected from the new EU Member States. With his signature modesty, he commented on his success in the following way: "I perceive my election as a tribute to the millions of citizens of our countries who did not surrender to the regime". In his keynote speech, he presented the following to be the priorities of his mandate: promoting the idea of the European Energy Community; promoting democracy and defending human rights; strengthening co-operation with EU neighbours in the east and south of Europe; increasing the EU's role in the multipolar world; long-term EU budget according to the needs and ambitions of the enlarged Union; developing the European Parliament to play a bigger role after the entry into force of the Lisbon Treaty. Professor Jerzy Buzek constantly pursues restoring the meaningful role of coal in the European economy with its new, environmentally friendly use.

Professor Jerzy Buzek obtained the title of doctor honoris causa at the universities in Dortmund, Seoul, Isparta, the University of Silesia in Katowice (2010), the Opole University of Technology (2006), the Silesian University of

Technology (2007) and the Lodz University of Technology (2010).

The following awards and titles highlight appreciation for his involvement and skills: the Chair of the Year 1998 (The Warsaw Voice), the Grzegorz Palk Award (1998), the European of the Year (the EU Forum of the Chambers of Commerce, 1998), the Man of the Year of the Wprost weekly magazine (1998), the Gustaw Adolf Award (2004), the MEP Award in the category of "Research and Technology" (The Parliament Magazine, 2006), the Silesian Quality Award (2007), the Man of the Year of the Silesian Voivodeship (Forbes, 2007), the Medal of the Silesian University of Technology, the Professor Stanisław Ochęduszko Medal, the Władysław Grabski Lewiatan Award (2008), the Silesian Oscar (2008), the Golden Badge with a Diamond of the Wrocław University of Science and Technology Senate (2008), The Best Polish MEP (according to the rankings by Wprost i Rzeczpospolita), the Wiktor Award for the most popular politician (2009), the BCC Special Award - Leader of the Polish Business (2009). 1998 and 2009 - title of the "Man of the Year", 2007 - title of the "The One who Changes Polish Industry", 2011 - title of the "Diamond Engineer 2011",

2012 – distinguished as the "Outstanding Polish Man" – for the overall performance in the work for Poland and for the Polish people.

Herbert Wirth - a Polish engineer, geologist, manager, professor of technical sciences, since 2009 the President of the Management Board of KGHM Polska Miedź S.A.( KGHM Polish Copper plc.) He is a co-founder of the think tank Poland Go Global. In 2009, he became the General Director of Mining of the 1st Degree, appointed by the Ministry of Economy. He is a member of the EIT Raw Materials Management Committee with its seat in Berlin, of the Mineral and Energy Economy Research Institute at the Polish Academy of Sciences, the Polish Association of Mining Engineers and Technicians, the Mining Sciences Committee at the Lower Silesia Branch of the Polish Academy of Sciences in Wrocław. He initiated the founding of the Polish Association of Mineral Asset Valuators, of which he is also a member. He was granted the title of doctor honoris causa by the Wrocław University of Economics and the AGH University of Science and Technology in Kraków, as well as many awards and honorary badges. The author and coauthor of more than 13 monographs, 95 research articles, 63 research theses and over 70 expertise papers concerning the evaluation of investment possibilities.

KGHM Polska Miedź S.A. (formerly: Kombinat Górniczo-Hutniczy Miedzi) – a company, one of the largest Polish State Treasury companies, one of the main producers of copper and refined silver in the world. According to the data of KGHM, it is the sixth largest producer of electrolytic copper (approx. 500-550 thousand tons) and the largest producer of silver in the world (approx. 1260 tons of refined silver in 2011). KGHM produces also gold (903 kg in 2008), palladium and platinum concentrate (93 kg), lead and other metals, although those in smaller quantities. KGHM also extracts rock salt. KGHM is one of the largest companies listed on the Warsaw Stock Exchange, it is a part of the WIG20 and WIG30 indexes. It was a part of the group of 16 companies which had their debut on November 19, 2009 at the Warsaw Stock Exchange creating the RESPECT Index. Those companies obtained the highest ranking class they became the leaders in the ranking.

KGHM Polska Miedź S.A. employs over 18,000 employees. Another 10,000 (not including KGHM International) work in the KGHM Polska Miedź S.A. Capital Group. Including the employees of the companies co-operating with KGHM, one can say that Polska Miedź employs over 100,000 people. KGHM Polska Miedź S.A. completed the 2009 strategy, giving its shareholders more than the average return rate:

- The rising trend of production costs was reversed since 2012 a mid-year drop of production costs per ton by 2 percent has been recorded;
- KGHM expanded its resource base and significantly increased the production of copper in 2012 Quadra FNX was acquired for a good price. Thanks to the active expansion completed with the acquisition of Quadra FNX, the company joined the global copper producers in 2014 a world class project called "Sierra Gorda" was launched the total resource base increased by 12 million tons of copper, i.e. by over 40 percent.

Development and implementation of new technologies makes KGHM a global leader guiding the industry towards new directions of development;

- KGHM's operations have been diversified due to the increase of the resources base KGHM has got extraction projects in Europe, North America and Chile production has been broadened to other non-iron metals (molybdenum, gold);
- KGHM remains an important partner in the region, generating 40% of the local taxes and directly employing nearly 40,000 people;
- KGHM introduced management by goals for key managers and worked out a number of programmes promoting the transfer of knowledge and development of talents in the company.

Following the path of the existing strategic directions, KGHM sets a new goal – to achieve the level of production of over 1 million tons of copper from own resources by 2020:

- KGHM's New Strategy will be based on three pillars: development of the resource base (a wide programme of exploration in Poland and in the world, as well as potential further acquisitions of pre-production assets); development of assets (an investment programme focused on the current projects with the value of PLN 27 billion by 2020); optimization of production (decreasing the Capital Group's C1 production costs by about 10 percent by 2020);
- At the same time, KGHM is developing innovative technologies in the area of production and processing of metal ores, which will translate to durable competitive advantage and to a long-term increase of goodwill;
- KGHM is an attractive investment due to good perspectives on the copper market, rich resource base, diversified portfolio of world class projects, experienced employees and stable shareholding policy (up to 1/3 of the net profit).

In 2012, Mr. Herbert Wirth was awarded with the "Bene Merito" Honorary Badge and, in 2013, with the Golden Cross of Merit.

Wojciech Kuśpik – President and shareholder of the PTWP Group, the author and editor of specialist media. The initiator of the European Economic Congress – the biggest and the most prestigious business event in the Central Europe.

From the beginning a businessman in the private market, as the owner and co-owner of companies, Mr. Wojciech Kuśpik is also the Chairman of the Supervisory Board of "Centrum Kreowania Liderów". He is the President of the Management Board of PTWP Online Sp. z o.o - a publisher of specialist business websites, as well as a member of the Supervisory Board of Atrem S.A. - a company present in the engineering industry and performing works connected with industrial automation and electro-energy. Since 2013, he is the President of Publikator Sp. z o.o. and Publikator.pl Sp. z o.o. - publishing companies connected with interior design and construction. In the years 2003-2006, Mr. Wojciech Kuśpik was a member of the management board of the Regional Chamber of Commerce in Katowice.

The PTWP Group publishes specialist magazines and websites. It focuses on chosen topics covering industry and economy (economic monthly "Nowy Przemysł", wnp.pl), real magazine property market (propertynews.pl), FMCG (the "Rynek Spożywczy" magazine, portalspozywczy. pl, dlahandlu.pl), agriculture (monthly magazine Farmer, farmer.pl, gieldarolna.pl), medicine and pharmacy (the "Rynek Zdrowia" magazine, rynekzdrowia.pl, rynekaptek.pl, infodent24. pl), local governments and municipal economy (portalsamorzadowy.pl), as well as HR (pulsHR. pl). President Kuśpik manages the company from the very beginning, being the editor in chief of a business monthly "Nowy Przemysł" and the website www.wnp.pl, as well as the editor of other portals and magazines.

The European Economic Congress, of which he is the initiator, is a three-day series of debates and meetings with the most important persons in politics, business, science and economics. Approximately 6,000 guests from Poland and abroad participate in 100 thematic sessions, debates and events accompanying the EEC. Topics at the Congress cover the most important issues concerning economic and social development of Europe: climate policies, energy safety, perspectives of the financial and banking sectors, challenges that the European Union is facing. In total, there are over 100 people working in the PTWP media group. The PTWP Group and its portals include: several dozen of complex branch websites, over 50 thematic portals, a few hundred thousand of current offers and advertisements in several categories, over 155,000 of recipients of everyday newsletters and alerts, over 5 million newsletters sent each month, 10 thousand pieces of information and nearly 9 million entries every month. The PTWP Group portals are visited by nearly 1.5 million unique users every month. During the last three years, the number of readers



increased a few hundred times. The number of global entries – nearly nine million, as well as the number of entries per one user increases systematically. Regularly, for a few years, the PTWP Group portals are present among the top business portals according to tests by Megapanel PBI/Gemius – the most representative in the Internet media market. The Institute of Media Monitoring (Instytut Monitorowania Mediów) ranking, which presents the most opinion-forming media, the wnp.pl portal was, for the second consecutive year, in the TOP TEN of all Polish Internet services. This is the result of the company's efforts related to investing in the uniqueness and quality of information.

She is the winner of numerous awards and many honorary awards, i.e., she was chosen six times as the best voit in Poland, three times as the best local governor in the country, numerous times - Voit of the Year, Woman of Success 2011, European of the Year 2011, Manager of the Year 2011, VIP in Business 2013, Businesswoman of the Year 2013, decorated with the Knight's Cross of Order of Polonia Restituta, with the silver badge "The Child's Friend", with the gold medal for merits in the area of state defence, with the Honorary Badge of the Polish Association of the Blind, the badge for merits for the Association of Veterans of the Republic of Poland and Former Political Prisoners, the golden badge of the Polish Union of Pensioners, Annuitants and Disabled.

She enjoys immense respect and trust of the residents. She takes care of the versatile and sustainable development of Lesznowola, including the education, sporting and recreation infrastructure, strategic and municipal roads and of the high standard of services rendered by the commune; she also inspires social and economic activity of the residents.

She has been the Voit of Lesznowola for five terms of office, being the candidate from the Election Committee of Voters of Maria Jolanta Batycka-Wąsik. In the last elections, she received about 80% of votes. Since 1998, Maria Jolanta Batycka-Wąsik makes sure that Lesznowola represents high level of spatial planning, attractive investment sites and dynamic local government, good place for the development of entrepreneurship that is attractive for investors, ecologically clean, comfortable, interesting and friendly to its residents.

She is an optimist and a person who builds positive relations with the world. Speaking of her work, she says that, "Managing the commune gives me immense satisfaction. Together with the local leaders and my professional team we have a real impact on the beauty of our commune. Here I fulfill myself. The term "problems" sounds pejoratively and I don't use such category in managing the commune. There are challenges that I take on and expectations which I try to fulfill. For many years, Lesznowola schools obtained the highest results in external tests and exams, which ranks them in the group of 4 percent of the best schools in Poland. Many interesting and innovative projects have been carried out there. One of them was the first in Poland exemplary social enterprise for autistic people - Pracownia Rzeczy Różnych in Wilcza Góra. To make this happen, Lesznowola took part in the Partner Project for Development organized Community **EQUAL** Programme. With regard to Pracownia Rzeczy Różnych, it is a public-private co-operation. It is impossible to enumerate all the undertakings that have taken place and had and amazing impact on the commune's development. The Voit adds: "I think this has been a good time for Lesznowola... And the Bene Meritus Award is undoubtedly a sign of respect for the management style of the commune."

Prof. dr hab. med. Grażyna Rydzewska manages the Clinic of Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology of the Central Clinical Hospital of the Ministry of the Interior and Administration in Warsaw. Since 1998 she has also been the deputy director for medical treatment at that hospital. She is a long-term national consultant in the field of gastroenterology.

Since 1985 she has been a co-researcher and head researcher in about 40 clinical research studies concerning the gastroesophageal reflux disease, IBS, IBD, peptic ulcer and other illnesses. She is a 2nd degree specialist in internal medicine and a 2nd degree specialist in gastroenterology. In 2014, she received the "Good Clinical Practice" Certificate. Professor Rydzewska is particularly interested in proteolysis and anti-proteolysis acute pancreatitis, experimental acute pancreatitis, pancreas regeneration, intracellular signal transduction in pancreatic cells, pathomechanism of inflammation development in acute pancreatitis and nonspecific enteritis, pain mechanism in IBS, Helicobacter pylori infection vs. dyspepsia and reflux disease.

She is known for her engagement in actions for patients with enteritis. Prof. Grażyna Rydzewska created the National Register of people with Crohn's disease. She initiated and runs the only clinic in Poland for treating enteritis. She is the President of the Polish Pancreas Club. She is the chief editor of "Przegląd Gastroenterologiczny". She operates the website: www.elitarni.com.pl which is a compendium of knowledge broadly nonspecific enteritis, including describing Crohn's disease. On the website, apart from purely theoretic information, a patient can find many practical tips on how to live and manage with intestinal diseases. The aim of the website is to make people with this illness regain faith in themselves in order to fulfil their dreams and passions, and live actively.

She is the Professor of the Świętokrzyska Academy (The Jan Kochanowski University in Kielce), a member of the Management Board of the Polish Pancreas Club, Vice President of PTG-E, a public health consultant of the Ministry of the Interior and Administration in the area of gastroenterology, a member of the Science Board in the "OnCOReview" journal, the editor in chief of the "Problemy Lekarskie" magazine, Vice President of the Commission for Monitoring of Quality in Medical Services at the Central Clinical Hospital of the Ministry of the Interior and Administration, a member of the Therapeutic Committee at the CCH of the Ministry of the Interior and Administration and of the Ethical Commission at the CCH of the Ministry of the Interior and Administration, since 2000 a member of the Commission for Gastroenterology and Hepatology of the Clinical Pathophysiology at the Polish Academy of Sciences. She is a member of the International Association of Pancreatology, the European Pancreatic Club, the Polish Internal Medicine Physicians' Association, the XXI Surgeons' Club, the Polish Society of Gastroenterology.



Professor Grażyna Rydzewska says about herself: "In professional, as well as in private life, I put maximum energy into what I do. I am lucky because my work is at the same time my passion."

Professor Grażyna Rydzewska has been awarded many times for her professional and research activity by university authorities and the Ministry of Health for the series of works in the area of pancreatology, she also received the silver and gold Cross of Merit from the President of the Republic of Poland. In 2014, she received the title of Woman of Medicine 2014, obtaining the largest number of votes.



Przemysław Talkowski - a reporter, lawyer, in private a drummer and a fan of kiteboarding. A graduate of the Faculty of Law and Administration at the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań. He has been associated with Polsat News from the start of the channel's activity. Previously, he was a reporter in TV Biznes. He is the host of the programmes "Państwo w Państwie", "Biznes Informacje" (Business Information) and "Nie daj się fiskusowi". The programme "Państwo w Państwie" is the only programme showing cases of abuse of law, nepotism in the stateentrepreneur, and state-citizen relations. The reporters of this programme reveal pathologies, stigmatise dishonest officials and claim justice for the victims. Every episode of the programme "Państwo w Państwie" shows the story of people who fight with bureaucratic abnormalities, lawlessness, incompetence, misappropriation and pathologies which result in business bankruptcies, personal people's tragedies, job losses, and exclusion.

The programme received, i.a., the Grand Press award in the category of journalism and the Wektory-2013 distinction given by Employers of the Republic of Poland.

Editor Przemysław Talkowski was distinguished by the National Bank of Poland in the Władysław Grabski competition for the best economic journalist in 2009. He is a prize-winner of the prestigious Grand Press award in the category of journalism in 2012 and a prize-winner of the Wektor 2013 - an award given by the Employers of the Republic of Poland. This prize is given to people and institutions whose activities are beneficial to the Polish economy, create an atmosphere for the development of entrepreneurship and are a model to follow. 

of the Polish Former coach football representation Andrzej Strejlau is one of the most respected trainers and experts in football, an undisputed authority among trainers. He was always guided by thoroughness, transparency and honesty in sports. He had many functions in the Polish Football Association (PZPN), inter alia, the President of the Panel of Judges, the manager of the department of training and the spokesperson. He was also the President of the Association of Football Trainers and an honorary member of the Polish Football Association. He worked at foreign clubs as a trainer in Iceland (Fram Reykjavik), Greece (AE Larisa) and in China (Shanghai Shenhua). A graduate of the University of Physical Education in Warsaw, in his youth he trained football and handball in Warsaw clubs. He is a great football devotee, for years a respected sports commentator and expert in many TV stations, author of popular science publications connected with physical fitness and football, co-author of the publication on the unification of football training methods and EU publications on corruption in sport, and lecturer

at courses and conferences in Poland (training conferences), in Europe (UEFA tournament), in Uruguay (lectures at a trainer school), in China (lectures in Shanghai and Kuming).

Andrzej Strejlau has many training successes, i.a., a bronze medal in the European Youth World Cup, a silver medal in the World Cup, silver medal in the Olympics, champion and winner of the Iceland Cup, winner of the Greece Cup and quarter-finalist of the Cup of Cup Winners, winner of the Cup and Supercup of Poland – Legia Warszawa, runner-up and finalist of the China Cup – Szanghai Shenhua, bronze medal in China Sports Olympics (Shanghai representations up to 21 years of age). 

"for exceptional input into promoting the heroism of the people of Warsaw during the Warsaw Uprising and for shaping patriotic attitudes among the young Polish generation"



The Warsaw Uprising Museum – a historical museum established in 1983 as a Museum and Archives of the Warsaw Uprising. The Museum was opened on July 31, 2004, a day before the 60th anniversary of the beginning of the uprising. This place documents the history of the Warsaw Uprising. It conducts research and educational activities connected with the uprising, as well as the history and actions of the Polish Underground State. It is a tribute to those who fought and died for the freedom of Poland and its capital city showing to the next generations of the Polish people the meaning of those events. Warsaw Uprising Museum has got over 30,000 exhibits.


The permanent exhibition presents combat and everyday life during the uprising with occupation in the background, followed by a description of the insurgents' fates in the post-war Poland. It consists of about 1,000 out of 30,000 exhibits that have been gathered: weapons, documents, letters, personal belongings, 1,500 photographs, over 200 biographies and historical information, as well as maps, tables and films from 1944.

In the first 10 years of its functioning, over 4.6

million people visited the place.

The museum is interactive and narrative: it creates effects with images, light, and sound. Interior design and application of multimedia effects bring closer the reality of the uprising. Many elements in the exhibition show the history of the uprising through the prism of experience and destinies of the insurgents. The new audiovisual technologies used by the Museum speak in an inspiring way about history and patriotism, especially to a young generation.

The permanent exhibition consists of three main parts, related chronologically. The first part shown to visitors is the one connected with World War II from 1939 until the end of



the "Operation Tempest", particularly focusing on the situation in Warsaw (the German terror, preparations for the uprising). Further, the story of the uprising from August 1944 is shown, as well as life in Warsaw during that time. The third part shows the situation in Warsaw until the end of the uprising, destruction of the city, exodus of the civilians, conditions of living of the insurgents in the German prisoner-of-war camps, as well as the international situation and establishment of the communist government in

Lublin. Exhibitions in the "Room of the Liberator" (Sala pod Liberatorem) supplement the whole exhibition.

Stefan Starzyński Institute is a branch of the Warsaw Uprising Museum which, through educational and research programmes, as well as through publicity, broadens the knowledge



educational projects which come out of the traditional education in school and professional training.

The Warsaw Uprising Museum was granted many awards and honours, among which the most important are: the 2005 event Museum of the Year "Sybilla 2004" Grand Prix; the silver and bronze medals for Merits in Culture "Gloria Artis"; in 2006, "The Cepif & International Herald Tribune Cee Property Awards 1989-2006: The Best of the Best" in the category of the Best Public Use Buildings built between 1989 and 2006; in 2011, the movie "The City of Ruins" was awarded with the Muse Award by the American Association of Museums (the film made in 3D technology is the only such reconstruction of the destroyed city); in 2014, during his official visit to Poland, the President of Estonia, Toomas Hendrik Ilves, decorated the Director of the Warsaw Uprising Museum - Jan Ołdakowski with the Order of the Cross of Terra Mariana of IV Class; in 2015, the Golden Reel Award in the category "Sound editing in a documentary film" for the movie "Warsaw Uprising".

on Warsaw, concentrating mostly on temporary history of the capital city and the issues connected with its development. In October 2004, the project "Oral History Archive (Archiwum Historii Mówionej)" was initiated. Its main goal is to record stories of a few thousand of the Home Army soldiers – participants of the Warsaw uprising, currently living in Poland and abroad. By 2014, the Archives had conducted over 3,500 interviews with the participants of the Warsaw uprising.

The Educational Section operating in the Warsaw Uprising Museum organises certified content-related and methodical trainings, open lectures and seminars and Warsaw and National

Prof. dr hab. inż. Zdzisław Nowakowski – the Dean of the Higher School of Information Technology, Management and Administration (known as the "Good University") is a graduate of the Faculty of Electrical Engineering at the Warsaw University of Technology and the Faculty of Foreign Trade at the Main School of Planning and Statistics (currently the Warsaw School of Economics). He has a PhD and a doktor habilitowany degrees in politics, which he obtained at the Faculty of Political Sciences at the Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin. Since 2002, he has been the Dean of the Higher School of Information Technology, Management and Administration, and since 2001, he has been employed as a professor. For many years he has been engaging in research, taking part in numerous research projects and conferences. He is the author and coauthor of hundreds of national and international publications, including about a dozen books in the area of IT, telecommunication, energy, administration, management, political science and the widely spoken security of the state. For about a dozen years he worked in the area of ICT, being in the management and supervisory bodies (i.a., Radomska Wytwórnia Telefonów S.A, PWP Mescomp S.A., Aster City Cable, TVM S.A). He was active in employers' organisations. Inter alia he was the President of the Economic Society in Warsaw and a member of the Management Board of The Union of Employers in Foreign Trade. He is a member of the European Society for Engineering Education, as well as an expert in The Mazowiecki Credit Guarantee Fund.

The Higher School of Information Technology, Management and Administration in Warsaw is a private higher education school with a very wide curriculum and full academic eligibility. It was established in 1999. It offers studies in the first and second cycle of education. The offer is supplemented by numerous trainings and postgraduate studies.

For over 15 years, the school has been the key to knowledge for thousands of young people. Taking into consideration the changing year-by-year labour market and the list of the most soughtafter specialists, the Higher School of Information Technology, Management and Administration in Warsaw constantly broadens and improves its offer, introducing new fields of studies and specialisations. A new programme is a series of interactive debates "Education for new economy". It is a series of meetings with young people, teachers and entrepreneurs in Mazowsze. The aim of those meetings is starting a discussion and working out a common mechanism of educating youth at the secondary and higher education level, with a strong emphasis on co-operating with entrepreneurs. The School co-operates with schools above the junior high school level. It supports and promotes a dozen of patronage schools from the entire Mazowsze region. For many years it has been organizing workshops in journalism, logistics and safety. They become more popular with each edition. The workshops are run by famous and popular radio, press and TV journalists, as well as specialists in the area of logistics and safety.

Andrzej Siezieniewski is a radio journalist linked with Polskie Radio (Polish Radio) since 1972, where he climbed the career ladder of a journalist. He manages the works of the Management Board, as well as co-ordinates all areas of the Company's operations. He supervises the works on the development strategy and the programme strategy of Polskie Radio S.A.

He actively represents Polskie Radio in the international arena. In December 2012, he became a member of the Management Board of the European Broadcasting Union almost unanimously with the votes of all the media people in the Central and Eastern Europe. This has made him the first representative of the Polish media in the EBU Management Board – the world's biggest organisation of radio and television broadcasters. He is also the Vice-President of the European Assembly of Economic Interests Euranet Plus – a radio organisation of broadcasters from all of Europe acting in the field of the European integration.

He is a prize winner of many journalist awards for his work in the radio and TV. In 2013, Andrzej Siezieniewski was decorated with the Commander's Cross of Order of Polonia Restituta. He also received: the Officer's Cross of Order of

Polonia Restituta, the gold Cross of Merit, the gold Medal of Merit for National Defence", the silver "Gloria Artis" Medal for Merit to Culture, the Medal of the National Education Commission, as well as the "Milito Pro Christo" Medal granted in 2012.

In 2004, the entrepreneurs' organisation, Employers of the Republic of Poland, awarded him with the "Wektor" prize – for courageous and creative realisation of the public radio's mission. In the same year, Andrzej Siezieniewski was awarded the "Buzdygan" prize – an award of the "Polska Zbrojna" weekly magazine for merits in the area of national defence, taking into account the input of Polskie Radio towards the technological and informative support for the Polish soldiers stationed in Iraq.


